### Michigan Health and Safety Coalition Joint Hospital Survey 2006

#### Scoring Ranges, Assignment of Bullets, and Bullet Labels For MH&SC Survey Questions Only

Summary scores reflect only the non-volume activities recommended in the MH&SC's guidelines ("recommended activities results"). They do not take into consideration procedure volume, which is shown separately.

Summary scores were computed according to algorithms specific to each guideline. Survey question weights and the scoring algorithms are specified in the hospital report templates provided in Attachment 2. Bullets were assigned according to particular ranges of summary scores as noted below.

##### Assignment of Bullets and Scoring Ranges

● ● ● ● ●	100% to 95.0 % of possible points
● ● ● ●	94.9% to 80% of possible points
● ● ●	79.9 to 60.0% of possible points
● ●	59.9 to 40.0 of possible points
●	39.9 to 0% of possible points

The labels attached to bullets reflect the extent to which hospital responses indicate that the non-volume activities recommended by the Coalition have been met.

##### Bullet Labels

● ● ●	Meets over 60% of guideline
● ●	Meets over 40% of guideline
●	Meets less than 40% of guideline
